- Greetings in the Name of the Lord Jesus.
- This is to say that we **greatly** appreciate your support for our work in Rwanda. Thank you so much.
- Our Open Garden with Coffee Morning in Ashburnham Village is on June 5<sup>th.</sup> Our lunch at the Brickwall Hotel is on 22<sup>nd</sup> September
- I will fly to Israel on June 16<sup>th</sup> to join all the ten Bishops of Rwanda and their wives at the GAFCON conference in Jerusalem.
- I fly to Kigali on July 17<sup>th</sup> to open a newly built, large church, at Bweyeye in Cyangugu Diocese. (Making sure it meets all the government requirements for 'health and safety!)
- The Lord enabled Jill to travel, on 20<sup>th</sup> April, the 9 hours to our daughter Jane's home in North Devon, where we went for Sue from Canada and Michael from New Zealand to meet together. With Jill's problems it was a complete miracle that she managed it!
- In my 18<sup>th</sup> year of retirement there is still plenty to do!
- We need £32,000 to complete the **last two** of the 16 houses for pastors in the Cyangugu parishes where they were renting a house at huge cost.
- Two of the 18 parish churches which were closed, have managed to fulfil the government conditions and are open again. 14 were not closed.
- We have paid the final bill for Pastor Innocent Habyarimana and the final bill for student Uwimana Paul, and also the first year's fees for Pastor Alphonse Nkurikiyumukiza (whose name means 'I amfollowing the Saviour), both from Cyangugu Cathedral, doing their three year degrees at the Bishop Barham University College, Kabale (£800 a year)
