

Concert at Tunstall Church

Quodlibet of Canterbury are delighted to be performing on **Saturday 18th May** for the first time in Tunstall church. Quodlibet in musical terms means 'what you will', and the programme, entitled A Musical Box of Delights, certainly reflects the variety of styles suggested by our name.

Since the group started in 2000 we have enjoyed exploring and celebrating the rich repertory written for mixed-voice small ensemble, one singer per part, generally unaccompanied. We like to mix and match the voices, and the programme includes solos and duets, as well as pieces in four- and five-part harmony.

We will be presenting a generally light-hearted selection from our Box of Delights covering four centuries: from William Byrd to Cole Porter, via some folk song arrangements by Vaughan Williams and others, and little gems both well known and neglected. There is also a sneak preview of an event on the Elizabethan composer John Dowland that we will be doing in October for the Canterbury Festival.
