

**Volunteer Transport Scheme** - Swale Volunteer Centre runs a Volunteer Transport Scheme for local residents who would otherwise be unable to attend essential medical appointments. For users of the service there is a small annual admin fee and a charge, payable directly to the driver, for each journey to help with petrol and vehicle running costs. There may be a number of reasons why you may not be able to use public transport such as age, disability, accessibility, times, mobility and costs.
