Volunteer Transport Scheme - Swale Volunteer Centre runs a Volunteer Transport Scheme for local residents who would otherwise be unable to attend essential medical appointments. For users of the service there is a small annual admin fee and a charge, payable directly to the driver, for each journey to help with petrol and vehicle running costs. Scammers

Every now and again it seems people are getting emails that purport to be from me or another member of the ministry team, with a link to photos, etc. An example is as follows: 'Just a few photos (from last Friday) - I'm sharing them cause I believe you know most of those guys'.

If it looks unusual, it almost certainly isn't from me! If in doubt, don't click on anything! *Alan*

BEWARE! We've been notified of people having their emails hacked. Emails are often titled **Catch up** and say: *Hello, How are you? I need a favour from you. I'm unavailable on phone, kindly let me know when you are online.* Please **do not** reply or click on any links - delete the email immediately!

Remember never respond to cold callers whether at the door or on the telephone, including fraudulent companies calling to inspect your Solar panels at no extra cost on behalf of the council, this is a scam. If your garden needs a tidy or your driveway looks a bit shabby use a safe trader, get one from https://tschecked.kent.gov.uk/

Doorstep scams - We are asking Kent residents to be alert to Doorstep Criminals knocking on your door following storms Isha and Jocelyn. They might tell you a tile has blown off your roof or that tree branches are overhanging a footpath and must be cut back immediately. Just say no and close the door on the cold caller. Never agree to work on your house or garden by someone who knocks at your door. Reputable builders, roofers and gardeners do not cold call. If you need storm damage work done visit the Trading Standards Checked website

Car scam - Resident bought a car online and paid in full. The following week their car had not been delivered and was now being advertised online but in a different location. They are no longer able to contact the seller.
